GUMMI'S 40SQM APARTMENT



Envisioned as a minimalist-pop apartment and unconventional oasis in Iceland's capital, this two-room flat juxtaposes clear lines and quiet tones with distinctive accents of colour. A candy-like pink and electric blue are used only on selected elements, like the painter's brush pattern on the wall of the living and dining area. Some sophisticated solutions enhancing the interior also have a functional task, like the ceiling with a geometric pattern made of foam typically used in recording studios that supports the acoustics. Others, like the electric blue curtain dividing the day and night spaces, are used in a decorative, nearly theatrical way. Some lively additions to the space are several lush green plants, creating distinctive spots in both rooms. The Italian bespoke furniture, custom-made by Falegnameria Caldini Luca, and also referring to the original colour palette, is a perfect fit for this futuristic interior. Minimalism with extravagant touches challenges the traditional Nordic style, infusing it with more colour and playfulness.
